If all goes as expected, the dioceses will vote to reunify as the Diocese of Wisconsin. This decision will then be ratified at the General Convention of the Episcopal Church next month in Louisville, Kentucky. We will continue to do our part to be witnesses for Jesus in Wauwatosa and beyond.

Trinity Garden Club


The grass is green and the birds are singing! Springtime is here!
