## ABOUT THE NATIVITY PLAY - 2009

This year's Nativity Play takes its cue from olden times. During the Middle Ages, the English village of York would stage "miracle plays"—drama paraphrasing Bible stories. The "York cycle" is the most complete group of manuscripts, containing 48 plays, all staged by guilds and artisan groups in York. The Nativity Play used here is also known as "The Tile Thatchers' (tilers') Play," updated in the 1970s by John Elliott and the Rev. Paul Bosch.
